

# Information about my tenancy


#### **IMPORTANT**

#### What is a tenancy (1)?



When you live in a house and pay money to a landlord for living there, you get a certificate.



It tells you what the rules are for living in that house.


This certificate is called a tenancy agreement.

#### What is a tenancy (2)?

How can a tenancy agreement help me?



The tenancy agreement tells you what you can do and what you can't do




It tells you about your responsibilities (the things you have to do).



It tells you about your rights (things that you should happen to make it fair).



It tells you about your rent.




It tells you when you can move in.




It tells you about what will happen if you break the rules

#### What is a tenancy (3)?


### How can a tenancy agreement help my landlord?



It tells your landlord about the rules that **they** have to follow




It tells the landlord about **their** responsibilities (the things **they** have to do).



It tells the landlord what they can do if you break the rules.

This is the person or group of people that looks after the place where you live



Make sure the electric works





Let the landlord or workmen in to do repairs




### These things are

When ...... goes out, they needs to make sure the doors and windows are locked.



..... must pay for things that belong to the landlord that are broken or lost on purpose



If ..... would like a pet, they need to ask the landlord first




..... must make sure that things do not get damaged by water




### These things are


responsibility (4)



..... must make sure that the sinks do not get blocked




If ..........'s friends visit the house, ..... must make sure that they do not damage things in the house.



..... must tell the landlord if they go away and leave the house empty for longer than 28 days


### These are the things that ..... must NOT do



..... must not break the landlord's things



..... must not sell the landlord's things



..... must not move someone else into the house without the landlord's permission

# These are the things that..... must NOT do (2)



..... must not use portable gas or oil heaters




..... must not decorate or make changes to the house



..... must not make too much noise or annoy the neighbours




### If..... breaks the rules



The landlord may write to ..... to tell them to move out of the house




## to move



6 months before she wants to move, ...... must write to the landlord to tell him that ...... wants to move.

On the day that ..... moves out of the house



The house must be clean and tidy



All the landlords things in the house must be clean and not broken



## If ..... wants to move (2)



All the landlords things must be in the same place as they were when ..... moved in.



..... needs to take all the things that belong to ..... out of the house.



..... needs to give the landlord ALL the keys



..... needs to go to the house with the landlord to check everything is OK
